

POULTRY SHOW - DEPARTMENT 7

Monday, July 18, 2022 thru Sunday, July 24, 2022

- **All exhibitors must abide by the *Rules and Information for Livestock Exhibitors and the IAFRE Code of Show Ring Ethics as previously detailed as well as all laws and regulations governing animal health issues.***
- **Entries:** Entry fee for poultry is \$1.00. Entries must be received by July 13, 2022.
- **Entries:** When entering animals into any Livestock Show at the Barnstable County Fair, the OWNER'S name MUST be used and not the farm name. Under NO circumstances will entries be allowed in both the owner's name and a farm name.
- **Arrivals and Departures:** Exhibitors must arrive with birds between 12:00 pm and 4:00 pm on Sunday July 17, 2022 and must depart between 6:00 - 8:00 PM on Sunday, July 24, 2022.
- **Health:** No poultry will be admitted to a fairground until it has been individually inspected.
 - All poultry must be free of visual evidence of the following diseases: infectious bronchitis, coryza, pullorum-salmonella, fowl-pox, external parasites and laryngotracheitis.
 - Each bird must be accompanied by written proof (ID card or test report) and banding that the breeding flock was blood-tested negative for pullorum-typhoid within one year prior to entry date
 - Any animal being treated for any ailment or parasite will not be allowed to be shown.
 - During the show, all animals will be examined daily for symptoms of disease, and any sick bird will be disposed of as the owner or Superintendent may direct.
- **Birds:** No birds vaccinated within 60 days may be shown. No birds under 4 months of age may be shown.
- **Judging:** No "For Sale" or identification tags on the cages before judging. Judging will be in accordance with the *American Standard of Perfection* and the Judge's decision is final.
- **Exhibitor:** It is the responsibility of exhibitors to keep their exhibits clean. The management will not be responsible for **any accidents, mistakes or damages that arise, the exhibit being the sole risk of the exhibitor.**
- **Rules of Conduct:** Any exhibitor who is caught or found out to have defaced or damaged any other exhibitor's animal or property will be asked to leave the Fair and will forfeit any premium money per order of the Livestock committee.

Premium checks are to be cashed within 60 days of receipt. No exceptions.

Premium check request deadline is October 1, 2022.
