

All disciplines are welcome! The only classes required to be in English tack, are ground poles, cross rails, 18" verticals, and 2'. Ground Poles will be Walk Trot only. Cross Rail division has an option to either trot or canter the jumps. Courses and patterns will be provided on the day of the show.

8. 2' Over Fences:
 - 8A. Hunter

9. Ranch Riding Division: There are three classes in this division:
 - 9A. Trail: Course will be posted.
 - 9B. Horsemanship: Pattern will be posted.
 - 9C. Ranch Riding Pleasure: Class to show collectively on the rail.

Fun Classes:

These will be held after the traditional classes.

10. Walk Trot/Jog Egg and Spoon: Riders will hold a spoon and egg while competing in a class similar to the classes in Division #3.
11. Walk Trot/Jog Canter/Lope Egg and Spoon: Riders will hold a spoon and egg while competing in a class similar to the classes in Division #4.
12. Chicken Race-Walk/Trot/Jog: Instructions will be given prior to the start of the class.
13. Chicken Race-Pairs Class: Riders will pair up and be required to each hold one side of a rubber chicken. Pairs will be asked to walk, trot/jog, and canter/lope.
14. Bareback Sit a Buck: The judge will place a dollar bill under each rider's leg (either left or right, but consistent among all riders.) Usually, it goes near the rider's knee, with enough paper extending out to be visible. Riders will be asked to walk, trot/jog, and or canter/lope.
15. Hobby Horse Class: No real horse required! Bring your hobby horse for a fun obstacle class!
